TANGARINE SINGS ABOUT THE REUNION WITH THEIR FATHER IN "SHADOW"

After three years of relative silence, Tangarine is back with their new single "Shadow". The song has a positive theme. The identical twin brothers Arnout and Sander Brinks wrote about the reunion with their father in 2013. Until then, they had not seen or spoken to each other for 18 years.

Arnout: "Shadow is about realising that you remain connected to your parents, even when you are not in touch. After our parents divorced when we were two years old, we regularly visited our father. Due to certain circumstances we were separated when we were 12 years old and did not see each for a long time." Sander: "When we met again I noticed how many similarities we share. Such as posture and characteristics. Like father, like son. We never knew how cool and special it is to recognize yourself in your father. The fact that we are back in touch is one of the best things that has happened to us in the recent years."

For Arnout and Sander, the Corona period was an opportunity to walk a new musical path and explore their talents as songwriters. Together with producer Gordon Groothedde, the twin brothers have recorded a number of strong pop songs, including this new track.

In 2014 Tangarine gained a great deal of popularity after being invited to perform as the official house band of 'De Wereld Draait Door', the number one Dutch talk show. It gave them a big visibility boost that resulted in a rapid growing fan base and sold out tours. In 2018, the twin brothers were also elected as 'best dressed artists by Esquire magazine, showing their feel for fashion and using the benefits of being twins.

This summer, Tangarine will start releasing new music. After months of hard work, they will return to the stage, performing with their band and presenting their newly developed live show.
